Robyn has a long term interest in women's health, safety and wellbeing, with over 25 years' experience working in policy, practice, academia and research-related fields. She has been CEO of WHW since 2008.

Session 2: Culturally appropriate responses

Monique Toohey is the Managing Director & Principal Psychologist at Nasihah Consulting - Northern Psychology Clinic. She is a specialist in Cultural intelligence, lecturing in Culture & Psychology and Cross Cultural Counselling at the Australian Catholic University and speaking internationally on intercultural competence & domestic violence. In 2014 she debuted the book, Without You: Rising above the impact of an abusive relationship. Monique has worked extensively with the Muslim community, schools, families and young people for the past 20 years and is a current Board Member of the Islamic Council of Victoria. Monique was the recipient of the recent 2015 Honouring Women in Moreland Awards for her capacity building work with women. She has been seen on ABC TV Hungry Beast, Lateline, featured in The Age, The Herald-Sun, ABC & 3AW radio.

Session 3: Keys to recovery

Jen Allen inspires all to reach their fullest human potential on the platform of respectful relationships in Leadership Coaching and Counselling as Executive Director of Victorian Institute of Counselling and Coaching. All students are required to complete a module in Family Violence as emerging counsellors through the course. She is a published author on the construct of resilience. For the past eight years through personal appearances, print, radio and television Jen has been actively speaking to the issue of preventing violence against women and developing respectful relationships. Jen works in partnership with Safe Steps (currently co-chair of the board), White Ribbon, Vic Health, AFL elite level players and Federal and State Governments. Now, with McAuley she is building the capacity for workplaces to Recognise, Respond and Refer around the issues of family violence. She has developed an elearning program for this.
